Dear Parent/Guardian,

In line with our school policy on Head Lice, we are obliged to inform parents if we observe that a child may have indications of head lice infection. This is a precautionary measure and in no way meant to cause offence, but is intended to assist and support families in tackling this problem.

There have been some indications that we have a current Head Lice infection at School. Our School Health Service recommends that you check your child by wet combing their hair as soon as is convenient, and that if live lice are found that you treat accordingly. It is **vital** that also close family and friend contacts are also checked by wet combing detection methods and treated as necessary.

This is a common problem that affects most people at some time or another, therefore do not be alarmed. Your School Nurse, Kim 03000 855730 is available for further advice and information.
