Thank you to those who have filled in <https://bit.ly/yemfeed24> . Please could you do so if you have not. Your feedback is important to me.

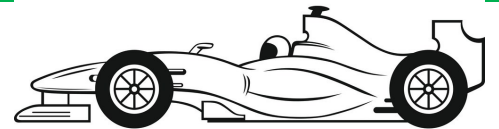

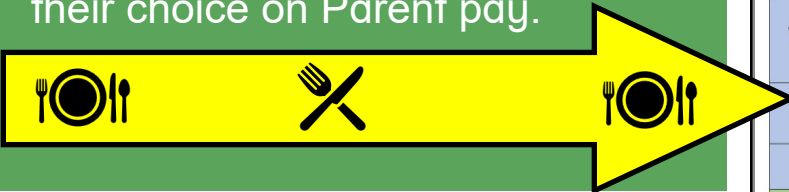

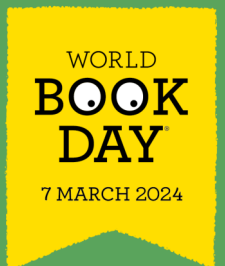
