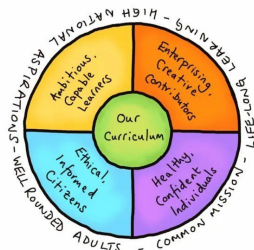
Area of learning and experiences
