We love children coming to school on their scooters and bikes. Please ensure your child is wearing their helmets to school. We don't allow them to ride their bikes in school without one.

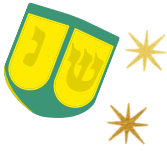

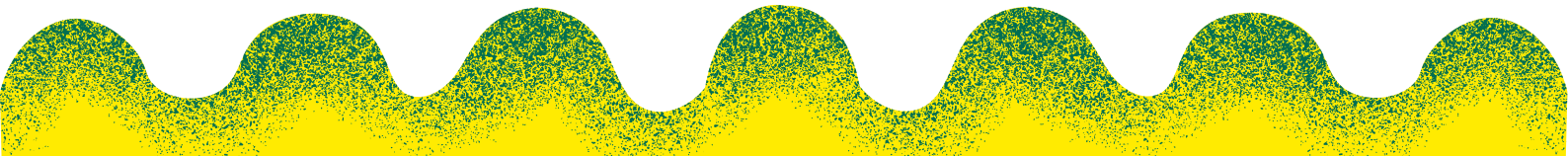
