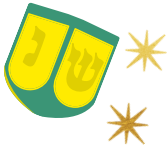

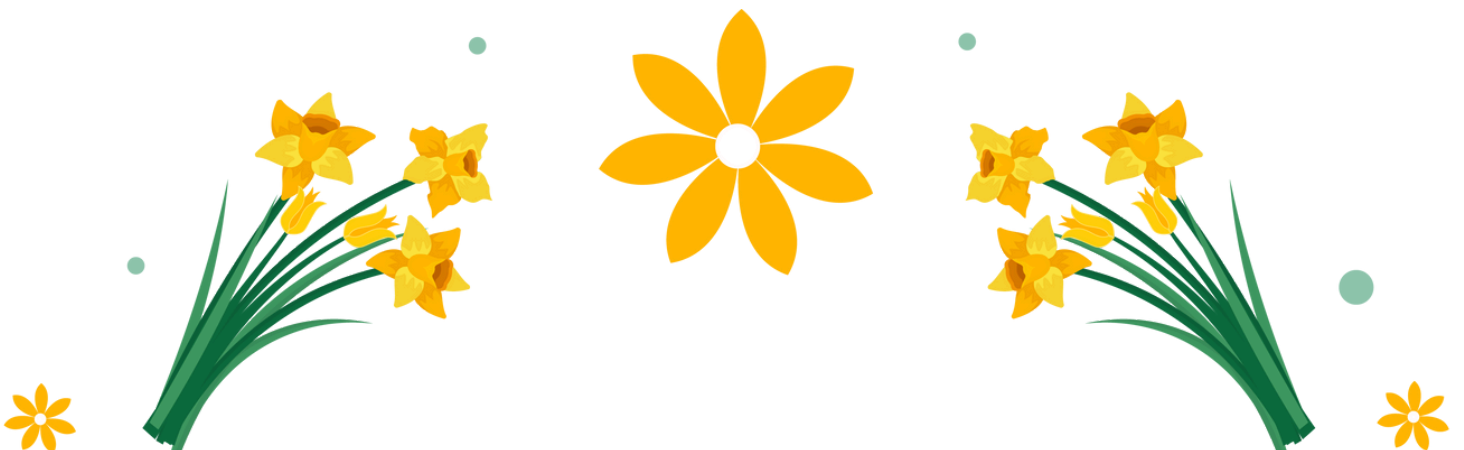

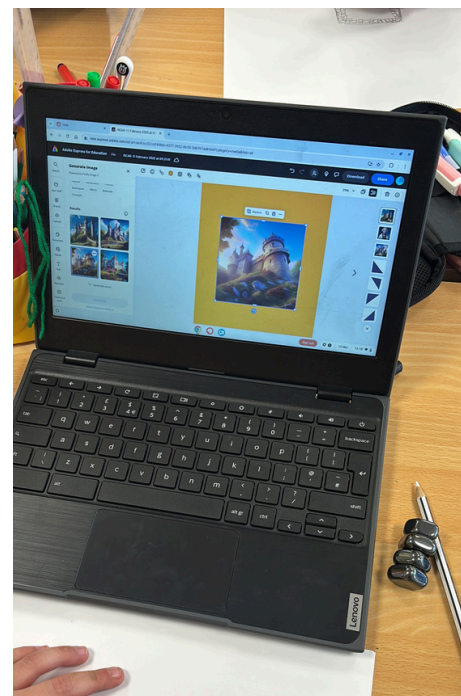
COMING SOON...

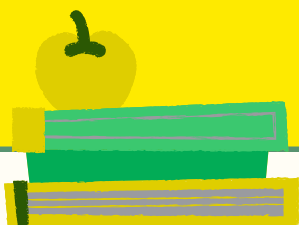

We have also been listening to lots of Wicked songs and learning the story behind the show.

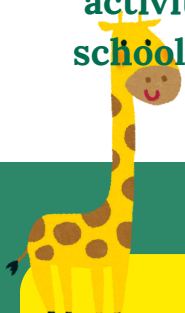
In Cymraeg we continue with our language patterns in the past tense ready to write our recount in Welsh when we return from our trip.
