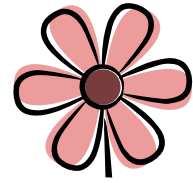

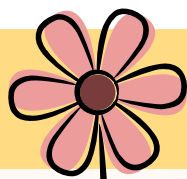

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Congratulations to Ethan, in Brenig, who has recently competed in The Menai Meet swimming gala in Llandundo, representing Gele Gators.

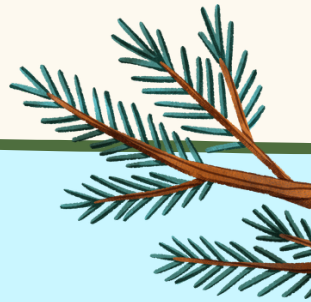
