In maths this week, we have been learning about perimeter and using our measuring skills to measure perimeter.

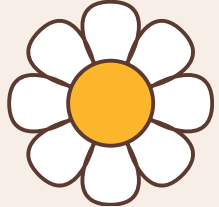
Our literacy focus for the next fortnight is Performance Poetry. We have learnt different features and have written our own class poem.

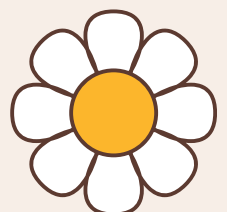
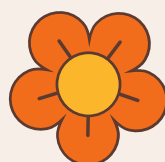
Atgoffa / Reminders

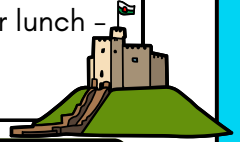

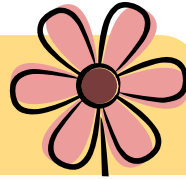
