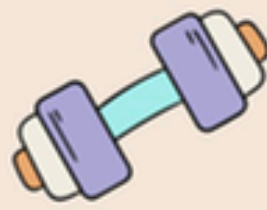

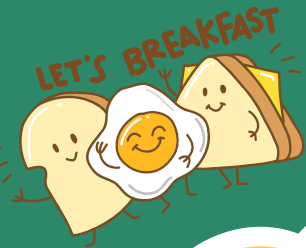

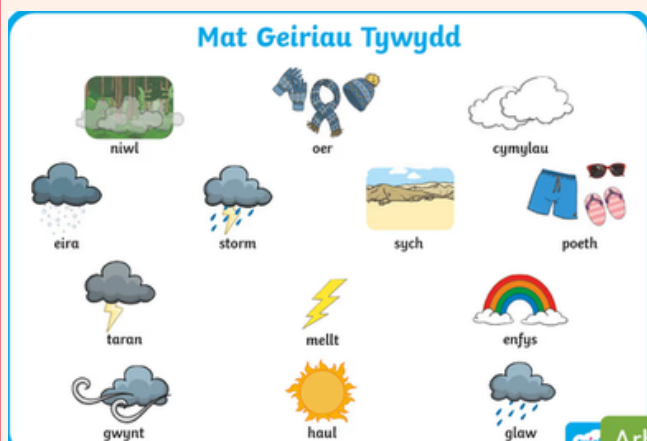

MEET OUR ENTERPRISE TEAM

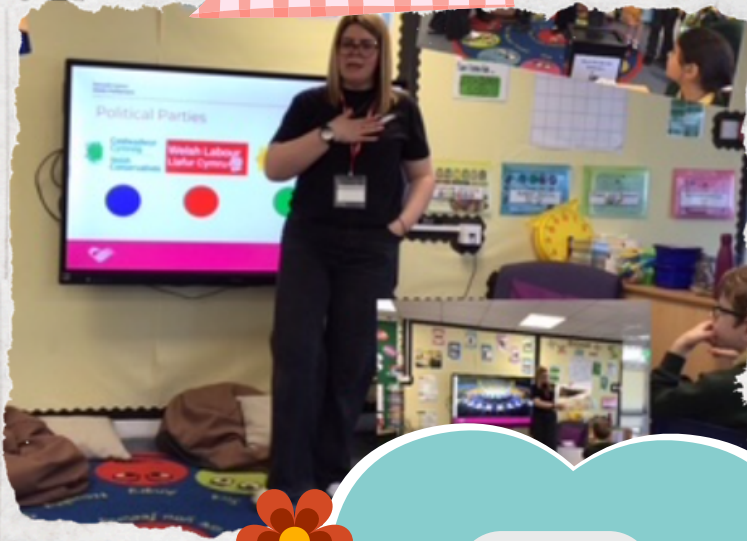
