Have a wonderful half term - enjoy the sunshine!

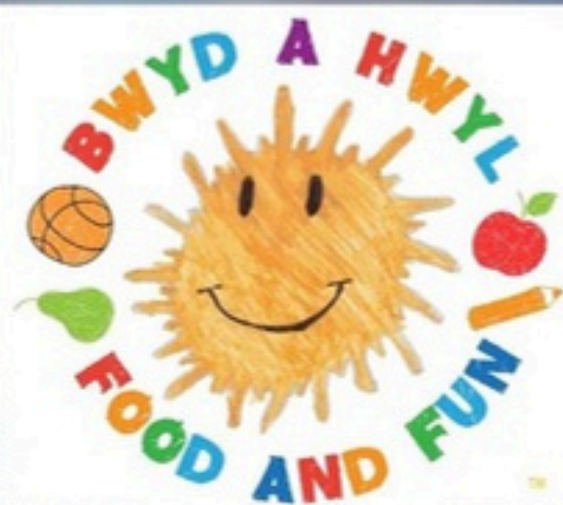

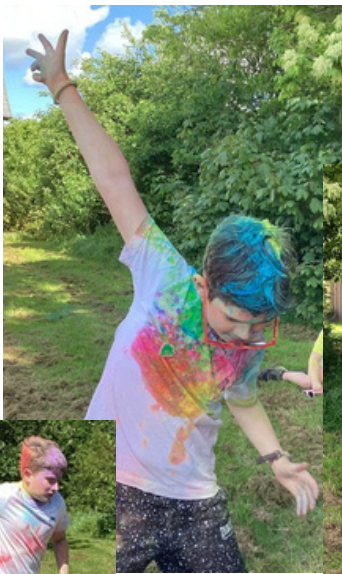

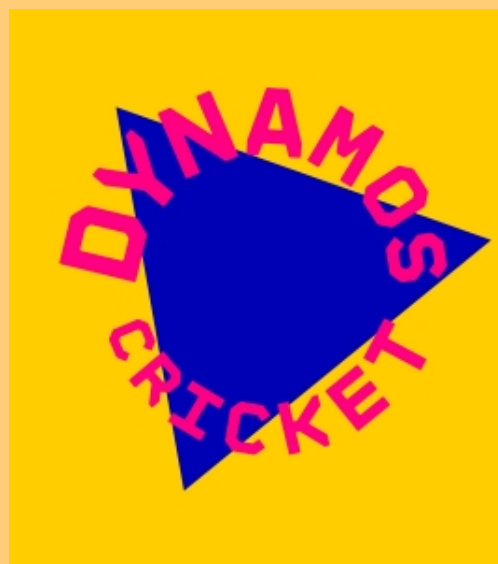


COLOUR RUN 2026

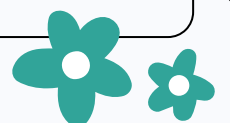
Please could we ensure that children bring their reading books and reading diaries into school each week please as there has been a noticeable change in children doing so.

WELL-BEING CABIN

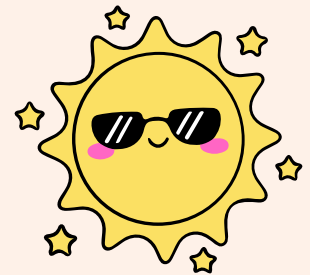
